Anatomy of an AI Agent Deployment

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You will work one family's move on your own phone.

WHAT IT IS

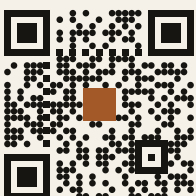
A card on your seat opens one family's move on your own phone in about twenty seconds: the record, the shipment, the housing, the visa, and an agent already working on it. For half an hour this room works that file together. Three rows we tap at the same moment, and four and a half minutes where you type whatever you like on it. Every answer wears its verdict, automate, govern or keep human, with the source it used, who approves it, and where it handed off.

The screen behind the stage shows the room at work, in your own words, with nobody's name on them. What the agent refuses goes to a person at a desk in the room, who answers two out loud and approves one thing for everybody at once.

HOW TO TAKE PART

Scan the card on your seat during lunch, and ask it one thing about the move while you eat. Type your first name. That is the whole setup, and there is nothing to install and no account to make. If your camera will not read the code, there is a short address and a four character code underneath it, and somebody at the door has a hotspot.

Bring your phone. Bring the question you think would break it.

THE SCREEN The wall behind the stage, with nothing moving. A filled block for automate, a half block for govern, an empty block for keep human, and the same three marks on the card you take home. The numbers in this picture are made up, because the session has not happened yet.

WHAT YOU GET OUT OF IT

- 1 A working agent on your own phone, so you can ask it the thing you did not want to ask out loud.
- 2 One decision rule you can take to your Monday, in three lines, on a card you keep.
- 3 Your own file, closed: every question you asked, what it did with each one, who answered it, and this room's numbers beside them. One tap mails it to you.

WHAT THIS SESSION IS NOT

Not a product tour. No prices, no slides, and nothing about how any of it is built. Every answer on every screen says what the deployment did and who is accountable for it.
